'Prez' worthy: Kovind salutes real life heroes

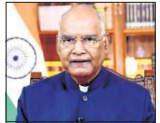

President Ram Nath Kovind on Saturday expressed solidarity with families who lost their kin to Covid and urged all Indian citizens to get vaccinated.

In his address to the nation on the eve of the Independence Day, the President said, "We know that this is the time of extra care and caution. Vaccines are the best possible protection science offers to us. Under the world's biggest vaccination campaign going on in our country, more than 50 crore fellow citizens have been vaccinated so far. Due to the new variants and other unexpected factors, we suffered from a terrible second

wave. I am deeply sad that many lives could not be saved and many more suffered immensely in this phase of an unprecedented crisis. I speak for the whole nation when I say that I share the grief of all the affected families with the same intensity."

ICONIC VICTORIA MEMORIAL TO BE COVERED WITH 7,500 SQFT TRICOLOUR

In view to celebrate 75th Independence Day, Victoria Memorial Hall, Himalayan Mountaineering Institute, Darjeeling and Vaidya Naty, Kolkata have decided to cover the landmark building Victoria Memorial Hall with a 7,500 square feet national flag.

Notably, the 7,500 square feet Indian National flag that will be dedicated to the nation by West Bengal Governor Jagdeep Dhanekar had begun its journey on April 25 this year when it was unfurled by officials of the Himalayan Mountaineering Institute (HMI) atop Mt Rhenock in the Sikkim Himalayas at an altitude of 15,500 feet.

The tricolour then travelled to Darjeeling, the Queen of Hills where it was unfurled once again at the HMI during the International Day of Yoga on June 21.

Ashoka Chakra posthumously conferred on J&K cop Babu Ram

NEW DELHI

Assistant Sub-Inspector Babu Ram and Constable Anaf Hussain Bhat of Jammu and Kashmir police were on Saturday posthumously conferred with the Ashoka Chakra and the Kirti Chakra awards respectively on the eve of the 75th Independence Day.

While the Ashoka Chakra is India's highest peacetime gallantry honour, Kirti Chakra is the second in order of precedence of peacetime gallantry awards.

President Ram Nath Kovind approved a total of 144 gallantry awards to armed forces, police and paramilitary personnel that included 15 Shaurya Chakras, four Bala Sena Medals (gallantry) and 116 Sena Medals (gallantry) and one each of Ashoka Chakra and the Kirti Chakra, an official statement said. While Babu Ram was an Assistant

TMC LEADER SHOT DEAD; 5 ARRESTED

A TMC youth leader was shot dead by unidentified persons in West Bengal's North 24 Parganas district, following which five people were arrested, police said on Saturday.

TMC alleged BJP was behind the killing, while the saffron party claimed that the murder was a fallout of infighting within the ruling party in the state. Sandhya Sharma Srivastava (33), a close aide of winner from Khardah assembly seat Kajal Sinha who succumbed to Covid, was shot dead near Sandhya Cinema on BT Road in Titagarh on Saturday when he was returning home in his car, an officer said.

Major terror bid foiled in J&K

Averting a major tragedy in J&K ahead of Independence Day, police have busted a module of Jaish-e-Mohammed by arresting 4 terrorists who were planning the collection of arms dropped by drones and supply to active terrorists in Kashmir, ANI reported.

According to Inspector General of Police, Jammu, one of the arrested JeM terrorists, Ijhar Khan alias Sonu Khan, a resident of Mirzan Mohalla in Kandala of Uttar Pradesh's Shamli, disclosed Munazir Manzoor alias Saifula of Pritchok Pulwama, a Jaish terrorist in Pakistan, had asked him to collect weapons from near Amritsar which would be dropped by a drone.

BSF ON HIGH ALERT

"Strict vigil is being maintained along the entire India-Pakistan border in Jammu and Kashmir and West Bengal and orders have been issued to strictly deal with anyone trying to cause any untoward activity along the international boundary," BSF Deputy Inspector General, Regional Headquarters, Shaendri Kumar Sinha said on Saturday.
